

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of Technical Institution, Graduate & Post Graduate at colleges and University level of India to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. Since inception of the NSS in the year 1969, the number of students strength increased from 40,000 to over 4 millions.

Sri Venkateswara Engineering Colege has **National Service Scheme (NSS)** Unit sanctioned in the year 2010 by Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Anantapur (JNTUA). The unit has adopted one village named "Annaswamypalli" which is five kilometres from the Institution. The institute follows the footprint of parent organization by organizing extension activities in the neighbourhood communities for sensitizing the students to social issues, service orientations, good citizenship and holistic development.

The NSS Unit of the institute is involved in conducting various awareness programs in the adopted village to understand the rural life, difficulties and challenges faced by the villagers. Every year NSS Unit is organizing one week Special Camp in the adopted village and also in the Anganwadi, Mandal Praja Parishad and Zilla Praja Parishad Schools with the help of local governing body and Grampanchayat. NSS Programme Officer, Students and NSS department coordinators spend one week of time in the village during the camp.

Expert lectures are organized for School Drop Outs, Health & Hygiene, Self employment, personality development, importance of cleanliness and environmental resources as well as awareness on government schemes. Villagers are trained in technical skills through PMKVY scheme for self employment every year.

Apart from the camp, the NSS Unit also organizes many activities like Tree plantation, Awareness Program on Hand washing and Disease Prevention, Swacchata Hi Sewa, Swacchata Pakhwada, Health checkup camps, supporting orphan children and vigilance awareness programs, Road Safety, National Unity Day, National youth day, International Day of Yoga and Vigilance Awareness Week etc. The Institute was recognized by certificates and medals for the extension activities.
